Emmanuel Métais appointed Associate Dean of Graduate Studies at EDHEC Business School

Paris, 1 October 2015 – Emmanuel Métais, PhD, has been appointed Associate Dean of Graduate Studies at EDHEC Business School. He takes responsibility for a portfolio of 13 programmes on the five EDHEC campuses and which includes the “Programme Grande Ecole” and the “Master in Management”, as well as the Masters of Science of the Business Management and Financial Economics tracks, representing close to 4 000 French and international students in the current academic year.
