

## THE GRADING SYSTEM USED AT EDHEC BBA

The French grading system is based on values from 0 to 20. At EDHEC BBA, 10 is considered passing and below 10 is generally a non-credited course. Faculty generally grade the majority of students within the 12,00-13,50 range and are asked to respect a standard deviation of no more than 2 to 3 in most classes. The European guidelines for grade distribution are provided as a framework in which faculty organize their assessments and grading policies:

ECTS GRADING EQUIVALENCY EDHEC BBA PROGRAMME	
13,00 - 13,99	B (25%) - Very Good
12,00 – 12,99	C (30%) - Satisfactory
10,00 – 11,99	D (25%) - Passing
0 – 9,99	F (10%) - Fail
Course with a grade lower than 10,00	<ol> <li>E (Equiv) if the final global average is upper than 12. Passing</li> <li>E (LEN – Jury decision) if the final global average is lower than 12. Passing Indulgence for visiting students can only be granted by the home university and with respect to their own evaluation standards and practices. So, at BBA EDHEC, each grade lower than 10 is considered as "Fail" for visiting students</li> <li>F (RESIT – Jury decision). No credit, Fail. The student must take a compensation exam to gain credit</li> </ol>

## CONDITIONS FOR OBTAINING THE EDHEC BBA DEGREE

Students obtain the EDHEC BBA Diploma when they meet the following conditions:

- Completion of 240 ECTS
- Each year, a global average of at least 12 or an average of at least 10 for each course
- Completed internship periods
- Bachelor Thesis
